Official transcripts should be sent directly from your institution to scholarships@weat.org or via mail to WEAT Scholarship Fund, 4908 Menchaca Rd, Austin TX 78745.

Transcripts may be mailed after the application but must be received no later than Thursday, May 1, 2025. If the University (or High School) is unable to send in the transcripts at that time, please let the Scholarship Fund (scholarships@weat.org) know when the application is submitted. If transcripts are not received prior to the selection date the application will be considered incomplete and the applicant ineligible for funding.

AWARD DATE:

Recipients will be selected by July 2025. Once a scholarship recipient is selected, a check will be issued to their respective university on behalf of the student. Scholarship stipends are distributed in two parts. The second is dependent on the student providing a mid-year transcript proving that a GPA of 3.0 or greater has been maintained.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

Candidate must be an active individual member or a legal dependent of an active member of WEAT. Log in to WEAT website here to check membership <https://www.weat.org/members/login>. A legal dependent is being financially supported by the WEAT member and is claimed on their income tax return. The student must be enrolled in college for the semester during which funds are distributed. All scholarships are competitive and based on the ranking criteria provided.



Applicant's Checklist

- Is the length of active membership in the qualifying organization also clearly stated in the application?
- Is the academic degree to be pursued by the applicant, the college or university chosen and the applicant's intended career plans clearly stated in the application?
- Is your income level and/or the family income level (if applying as the dependent of a member and being supported by your legal guardian) clearly stated in the application?
- Is the past academic record of the applicant, whether in high school or previous college activity, clearly indicated in the application and have you provided a post-graduation high school transcript, GED or University Grade Report? **THE APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE WITHOUT THIS INFORMATION!**
- Are all current leadership and/or volunteer activities in the qualifying organization(s) (for the applicant or his/her legal guardians) clearly indicated in the application?
- Have you completed all the information requested?
